Legal Aid of East Tennessee helps seniors with legal problems. It does not matter how much money you have. It does not matter if you own anything of value, such as a car, a house, or property.

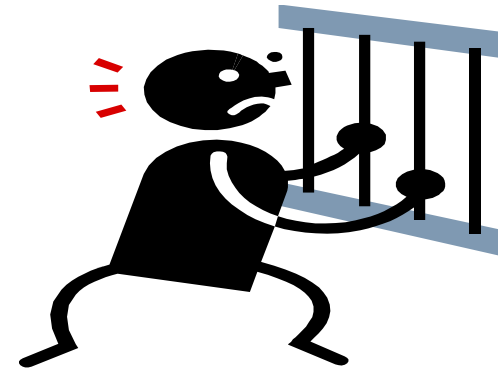
You can qualify for our services if:

1. You live in Bledsoe, Bradley, Blount, Carter, Cocke, Grainger, Greene, Hamblen, Hamilton, Hancock, Hawkins, Jefferson, Johnson, Knox, Loudon, Marion, McMinn, Meigs, Monroe, Polk, Rhea, Sequatchie, Sevier, Sullivan, Unicoi and Washington Counties.
2. You are 60 or older.

Legal Aid will review your case to see if it affects your basic needs. Some types of cases Legal Aid takes are:

- Medicare appeals
- TennCare problems
- Food Stamp problems
- Housing problems
- Nursing home appeals
- Social Security
- Being sued on a debt

Legal Aid does not take criminal cases. We cannot represent someone who is in jail.



- Call Legal Aid to get help over the telephone or to schedule an appointment to come into the office.
- Legal Aid representatives also visit the Senior Centers on a regular basis.
- If you are in a nursing home or home bound, a Legal Aid representative may come to you.
